Point of Information	Question the Speaker through the Chair-no direct dialogue with the speaker	No	Majority Vote
Motion to...	Call for voting procedures, etc.	No	Majority Vote
Motion to have a moderated Caucus	Debate among delegates with the assistance of the moderator	No	Majority vote
Motion to divide the House	To vote by roll call-no abstentions-if the vote is close	No	Majority Vote
Motion to amend a draft resolution	To vote for changes or addition to specific parts of the reso	No	Majority Vote
Motion to table or remove a reso	To remove/close a topic, debate, reso	No	Majority Vote
Motion to cancel the previous motion	Cancel previous motion before voting	Yes	Delegate
Motions to extend points of information	Add more points to the speaker	No	Chair
Motion to move into voting procedures	Stop debate and move to voting	No	Chair
The Delegate yields his/her time to the delegate of...	Gives remaining time to another delegate	No	Speaker
The delegate yields time to points of information	Gives remaining time to questions and/or more questions	No	Speaker
The delegate yields the floor to the Chair	Gives floor to Chair	No	Speaker
